Jet Aviation has spent some ten years in research and development to optimize sound and weight in VVIP interiors, delivering some of the industry's quietest and lightest cabins. In addition to this narrow-body, redelivered in 2022, they also delivered their quietest wide-body aircraft in late 2021.

"Our recent deliveries have continued to lead the industry in crafting exceptionally quiet and comfortable cabins without compromising on weight," says Jeremie Caillet, Jet Aviation's SVP regional operations EMEA. "To redeliver an aircraft that is not only light, but also exceptionally quiet, is a fantastic achievement, and testament to our continued work and innovation in this area. As we strive towards creating the ultimate customer experience, we are excited to continue to lead the industry in developing and shaping what is possible in cabin acoustics."

The cabin was also the completion center's first installation of flexible Organic Light Emitting Diodes (OLED) screens in a VVIP interior,

with three certified 55-inch curved OLED screens integrated on either side above the window line, following the curvature of the ceilings. Installation into the cabin wall in this way reduces the cabinetry required to house the screens, providing further opportunity for reducing the weight of the cabin and maximizing the floor space of the interior.

"The integration of the curved screens is a further step in our innovation journey as we continue to push the boundaries of VVIP completions," continues Caillet. "Not only do they provide opportunities for reducing the weight of the cabin, but they open up a new realm of possibilities in design and entertainment. We are extremely proud to be setting these new industry standards as we continue to innovate on behalf of our customers."

In order to certify the screens inhouse and install in line with aviation requirements, Jet Aviation worked with an electronics partner on a series of qualification analyses and tests to meet temperature, vibration, weight, sound, electromagnetism, flammability, and stress aviation standards.

The completion center is able to install the curved screens in both completion and refurbishment projects. **More on page 2.**

Gulfstream Service Expansions Continue in Savannah

All-New Gulfstream Service Center to Support Growing Fleet



SAVANNAH, Ga., April 6, 2023 — Gulfstream Aerospace Corp. today announced the continued expansion of its Gulfstream Customer Support Savannah-based maintenance, repair and overhaul (MRO) footprint at Savannah/Hilton Head International Airport. The latest expansion will create 250 new jobs and adds to the two existing Savannah-based service centers, the most recent of which opened in 2019.

This second phase of the new Savannah service center expansion represents a \$98.5 million investment and an additional 200,000 square feet/18,580 square meters and continues Gulfstream Customer Support’s strategic network growth around the world. The first Odyssean Edition was launched in 2021 to the Flying Spur family, and took design influences from the EXP 100 GT concept car that defined Bentley's view of luxury mobility in 2035 as part of its Beyond100 strategy. Similar to the Flying Spur Odyssean, the new Bentayga limited edition takes advantage of the benefits provided by a Hybrid powertrain.

Together, the Bentayga Hybrid's V6 petrol engine, electric motor and new and improved 18.0 kWh battery deliver a remarkable spectrum of performance, from the calm of near-silent, zero emission EV mode to thrilling full-throttle acceleration, with an electric-only range improved to at least 28 miles (45 km) on the WLTP cycle.

With a combined output of 462 PS (456 bhp), the 3.0-litre TFSI V6 petrol engine and 100 kW electric motor-generator can power the Bentayga Hybrid from zero to 62 miles an hour (100 km/h) in just 5.3 seconds, with a top speed of 158 mph (254 km/h). The sensation of effortless power is, if any-

thing, accentuated by the hybrid powertrain due to the capability of the electric motor to deliver its full torque output from zero revolutions per minute.
